## International Travellers



### PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS

To enter South Africa, all foreign nationals need a passport valid for at least 30 days after the intended date of departure. Ensure that your passport has at least two blank visa pages for entry stamps. Check your country's visa requirements with the South African embassy.



### ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

- Travellers arriving in South Africa are advised to declare their electronic equipment, including cameras and laptops, even if they intend to take these items with them upon their departure from South Africa.
